The Think Tank Photo Airport Security bag is a roller that includes emergency backpack straps for convenience. At 9" x 14" x 22," this roller/backpack meets most airlines' carry-on size requirements and can accommodate your gear, including up to a 600 f4 lens. The sides offer pockets that can be reinforced with a harder material if you wish.
